



Training workshop entitled:

First aid training

Based on the joint cooperation between the College of Applied Medical Sciences and the First Al-Sharafa Complex, the Social Responsibility Unit at the College trained some of the employees of the complex on Tuesday, 25/3/1445 AH, to carry out first aid for cases of wounds, fractures, drowning and also deal with cases of food poisoning.

Dr. Magda El Gameel, Supervisor of the Social Responsibility Unit at the Faculty, presented the objectives of first aid and the need to provide a first aid kit in all places such as school, home, car and workplaces, and what tools it contains to provide immediate assistance to the injured. She also reviewed the themes of the course such as ambulance cases of bleeding, drowning, and food poisoning.

It was followed by Dr. Sahar Ali, by presenting a presentation to ambulance cases of burns of different degrees, explaining the types of burns and providing immediate interventions to save the injured and not to have complications until he is transferred to the hospital to receive the necessary treatment, as well as fractures, explaining how to stabilize the injured organ and how to transfer it correctly, as well as training was done to measure the level of sugar in the blood, measure the pulse and blood pressure, and a video was shown on how to save the drowned. At the end of the training, the questions and inquiries of the attendees were answered, wishing them health and safety
