3. Faculty members shall respect the privacy and confidentiality of student information, including grades and personal disclosures.

### ❖ **Personal Responsibility and Compliance with Institutional Policies:**

1. Students take responsibility for their actions, whether academic, personal, or social, and recognize that their choices have consequences.
2. Students prioritize their physical and mental health and seek help when needed, supporting a culture of well-being for others and themselves.
3. Students comply with all institutional policies, rules, and regulations that govern their conduct as college students, both in and out of the classroom.
4. Students must report violations of this code of ethics and other campus policies when they become aware of them, recognizing that such reporting contributes to a just and ethical campus community
